

In Canada DID YOU KNOW?



In Canada mid-efficient furnaces have been phased out. This means that your next furnace will be a high-efficiency furnace, as the Canadian standard is 93%.

The higher the Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) rating, the greater energy economy is provided. Older furnaces may be rated at 60% AFUE, which means that for every dollar you spend on heating your home, 60 cents is spend heating the house and 40 cents is lost out the chimney.
